Rules and Regulations for Region One ESC
Battle of the Books 2018-2019

Eligibility

- The Region One ESC Battle of the Books competition is open to all STISD students.
- Students in grades 7 & 8 may compete in the Middle School division.
- Students in grades 9-12 may compete in the High School division.
- Team members must attend the same STISD campus.
- Team selection is at the discretion of the sponsor.
- A team is comprised of three students and one alternate.
- An alternate member is optional.

Battle of the Books Reading List

- The official list of books to be read will be posted on all the district library websites and will be distributed to sponsors by district library staff.
- The book selections are based on state award book lists.
- Copies of each book will be available for checkout at each library.

Procedures

Round One

- November 2018.
- 20 question written test.
- 15-minute time limit.
- Questions provided by BLA librarians.
- Each team will work on one test together.
- Testing on two books only for junior high:
 - *Refugee* by Alan Gratz
 - *Well, That was Awkward* by Rachel Vail
- Testing on two books only for high school:
 - *The Hate U Give* by Angie Thomas
 - *The Inexplicable Logic of My Life* by Benjamin Alire Saenz
- Top two scoring teams from each campus will advance to Round Two.
- Students advancing to Round Two will receive t-shirts.

Round Two

- January 2019 in Mercedes.
- Face-to-face round robin style competitions.
 - Teams will be allowed to discuss before answering.
- Junior High competition.
 - Two RSA teams and two STPA teams will compete at same time.
 - Winning team will represent STISD at Region One Middle School competition.
- High School competition.
 - Two teams from each high school will compete at same time.
 - Winning team will represent STISD at Region One High School competition.
- Questions will be provided by Region One committee.
- Number of questions to be determined.
- Testing on all five books for junior high.
- Testing on all five books for high school.
- Winning junior high team will receive district traveling trophy.
- Winning high school team will receive district traveling trophy.

Round Three

- Region One competition.
- Face-to-face round robin style competition.
- Competition will be held during school day.
- Teacher or librarian sponsor must accompany team to Region One competition.
- One STISD junior high school team will compete against other school districts.
- One STISD high team will compete against other school districts.
